Roxbury Community College Archives

The RCC Archives is the central repository for records in various formats – manuscript, audio-visual, and digital – that document the history, mission, programs, and policies of RCC. Its mission is to collect, preserve, and make accessible these records, and to promote an understanding of the RCC legacy, past, present, and future. The Archives contains records from 1968 – present and consistently accessions new records.

The Archives is divided into 16 series or categories that reflect the originating department or type of records created. In the fall of 2014, RCC President Roberson announced the reorganization of the college's administration. 4 new series were created as a result of these changes, and some series stopped being in use. The Archives also contains past and current electronic records for the College, which are not listed here.
